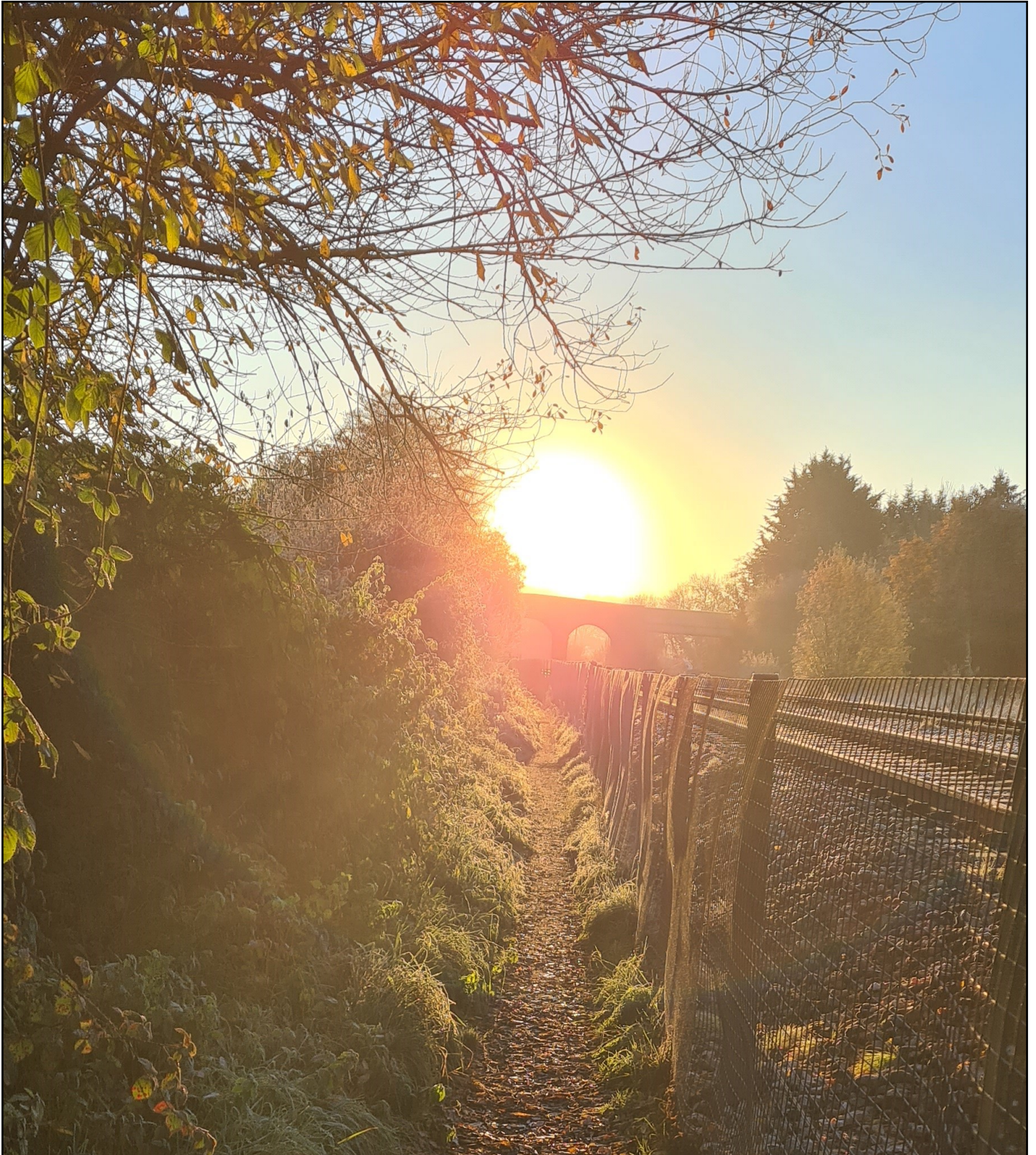

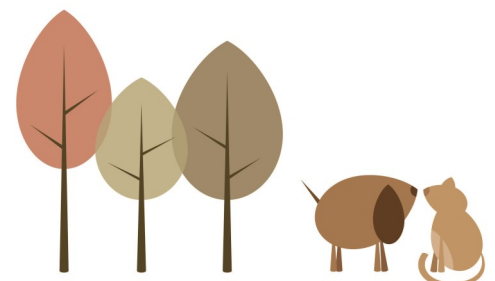

CREDITON HAMLETS PARISH COUNCIL

Problems with dangerous speeding in Yeoford were discussed again at the November Crediton Hamlets Parish Council meeting. Councillor Yarnold reported on the cost of 20 mph signs. Councillors resolved to purchase a metal sign to go up near the school and 3 plastic signs to go up at entrances to the village. Although these will not be legally enforceable, Councillors hope drivers will take notice and slow down. With the support of Cllr Letch (DCC) the Parish Clerk is researching the purchase of a Vehicle Activated Speed Sign which could be used in the village. To reduce costs, the sign would be shared with 3 other parishes.

Cllr Beasley explained that a resident had contacted the Parish Council regarding a Christmas lights initiative for the village. Councillors thanked the resident for her interest. Councillor Yarnold suggested a "best decorated house" competition. Councillors resolved to support this and will provide a prize of a £50 voucher for use at The Duck. The identity of the judge and judging date are to be confirmed. The Clerk will produce posters to publicise.

Full minutes of all PC meetings are on the PC website. The next meeting will be at 1930 on 6th December at Yeoford Community Hall. County Councillor Newsletter

Almost 6 months as a county councillor and have attended a number of virtual briefings which have given me an overview of the services offered by the county council and what role councillors can play in their implementation.

The two latest briefings I have had have been on budget and the environment. It will be no surprise to any of us to know that officers are engaged in the very difficult task of maintaining services, with all the inevitable increases in salaries, utilities and materials, and maintaining a budget within the permitted guidelines Council Tax rules allow. The reason revenue component comes from council tax and so we shall all look with interest in the spring to what we shall have to pay.

The second briefing was on the environment! This was just three days before the COP26 conference in Glasgow began. What we know is that the largest contributors to the corporate emissions are the school buses which represent 42%. For those of us who see the buses trundling through our towns and villages it is no surprise. The buses are old, and here in Crediton they often have to negotiate very narrow roads which means that the idle for some time emitting their smelly polluting fumes. I wonder how they pass the emissions test which they surely need to do to be roadworthy. I'm pleased however to report that the officers are in talks with the bus companies to improve the service and to look at electric buses in towns. The County Council intends to install 240 electric vehicle charging points throughout the county by December 2022. There is also on the street charging grant which could potentially be used by other groups throughout the county. I was also surprised to learn that wind turbines are more than twice as efficient as solar panels at generating electricity!

While on buses I have to report that Queen Elizabeth School in Crediton is often reporting to me that buses are late getting pupils to school. I have raised this with the relevant officer who is in talks with the companies.

In the winter months I hope to carry on with my surgeries but I have to admit that December, January and February are always very cold and damp so I may not turn up. Do not worry because I much prefer people to e-mail me rather than telephone. My reason for this is that if you e-mail me I have a record of what you are concerned about and can then forward it to the relevant officer. With this in mind I reiterate my e-mail address which is

Avian Influenza Prevention Zone (AIPZ)

Heart of the South West Trading Standards Service have advised us that as of 5pm on the 3 November 2021 an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone was declared across Great Britain. This means that all bird keepers in Great Britain (whether they have pet birds, commercial flocks or just a few birds in a backyard are required by law to take a range of bio-security precautions:

Schedule 1 - Minimum biosecurity measures applying to all keepers

- Keep domestic ducks and geese separate from other poultry.
- Ensure the areas where birds are kept are unattractive to wild birds, for example by netting ponds, and by removing wild bird food sources.
- Feed and water their birds in enclosed areas to discourage wild birds.
- Minimise movement into and out of bird enclosures.
- Cleanse and disinfect footwear and keep areas where birds live clean and tidy.
- Reduce any existing contamination by cleansing and disinfecting concrete areas and fencing off wet or boggy areas.
- Keep free ranging birds within fenced areas, and ponds, watercourses and permanent standing water must be fenced off (except in specific circumstances, e.g., zoo birds).

Schedule 2 –Enhanced biosecurity measures for premises with over 500 poultry or other captive birds

- Keepers with more than 500 birds will need to restrict access for non-essential people on their sites, workers will need to change clothing and footwear before entering bird enclosures and site vehicles will need to be cleaned and disinfected regularly to limit the risk of the disease spreading.
