CREDITON HAMLETS PARISH COUNCIL

At the December meeting of the Parish Council councillors were updated on the petition to open the second platform at the station so that trains on the Okehampton line can stop at Yeoford.

Councillors resolved to make grants of £175 to Yeoford Chapel and Holy Trinity Church towards the upkeep of the churchyards. A grant of £150 to Mid Devon Mobility (which supports local residents) was also agreed. Councillor Price reported that the 20 mph advisory signs have been put up and that the Life Support Training held at the Community Hall on 27th November was very informative.

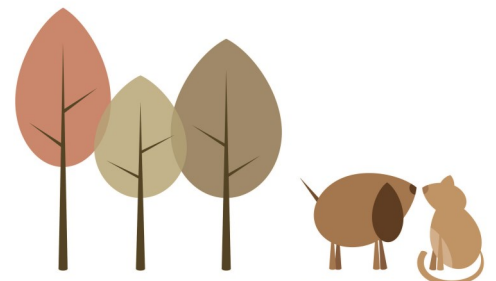

Introduction

Mid Devon District Council is conducting a parish review (formally known as a Community Governance Review). It is envisaged the review, which began in November 2021, will take around a year to be completed.

As part of the process the Council will be reviewing all towns and parishes in Mid Devon.

There are a number of options that may be considered during the review and these include:

- creating, merging, altering or abolishing parishes
- changing the name of parishes
- the electoral arrangements for parishes (number of councillors, warding)
- grouping parishes under a common parish council or de-grouping parishes



Send your comments



The Council is seeking your views on the current and future governance and structure of parish councils across Mid Devon.

We would welcome your comments.

This first phase of consultation runs from 16th December 2021 for a period of eight weeks.

Aim

There are a number of purposes to a parish review including:

- changing boundaries as a result of new buildings and growth
- altering anomalies when changes have occurred, meaning the current boundary is no longer relevant
- local people have expressed views on the current structure
- to bring about improved community governance
- to improve local democracy
- To provide more effective and convenient local services
- To improve or develop community identity

Outcome

At the end of the review period the Council will make a number of recommendations. The recommendations will be made available in a public document, including the reasoning behind each recommendation.

Recommendations could include:

- boundary changes
- revised electoral arrangements
- the abolition of a parish/es
- grouping or ungroup existing parishes
- changing the name of a parish council to reflect any boundary changes, as appropriate

Any changes as a result of the review would come into effect for the 2023 all out elections.

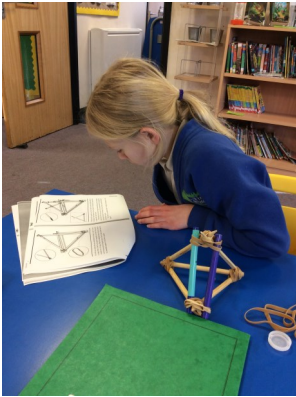
