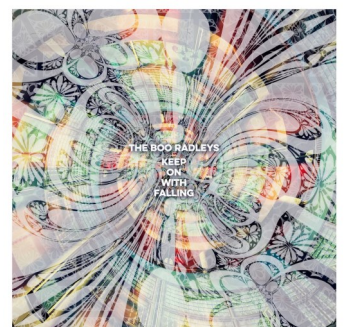

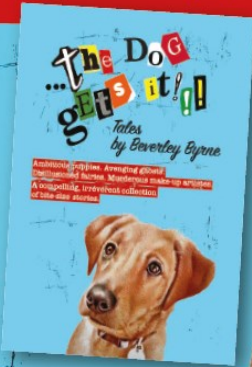

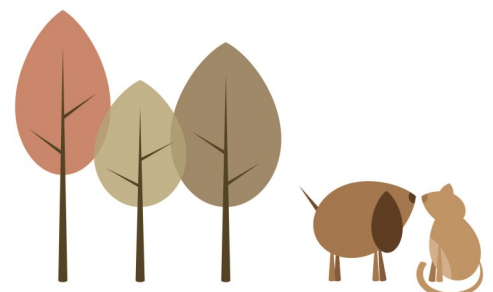
THE CORONATION WEEKEND 6TH TO 8TH MAY 2023

County Councillor Newsletter—February

The parishes and Crediton Town Council have now decided on their budgets and set their precepts. In general terms the parishes have made little change but Crediton Town Council has raised its precept by 17%. The town council has taken on several services devolved from higher tier authorities and puts on a number of events which are much valued by the town and its visitors. Crediton Town Council has published a comprehensive press release to inform residents.

Mid Devon District Council will finalise its budget soon but it is fair to say it will mean cuts and increases in charges. There will be increases in planning charges and on use of the leisure centres. There are several more smaller increases you can view on line. As the MDDC council tax is quite a large chunk of your final bill I suggest you look on line to see the final bill.

Devon County Council can raise its council tax by 4.99% and as this is over half your bill it is worth checking final figures. Much of the increase will go to children's services and to adult care services. There are 2 proposals that might effect many of you. The first is to instigate a consultation on paid parking on Crediton High Street (and in 7 other towns) and to raise the pupils' concessionary bus fares by 30%. My party is questioning both proposals.

It seems that the members Locality Fund is to be reduced. When I was elected, almost 2 years ago, it stood at £10k, which enabled me to fund a wide range of community projects throughout my division. Last year it was reduced to £8k and this year to £5k, which means it has quickly halved. At this rate it will disappear soon. Again my party is questioning the justification of such a dramatic change.

Potholes still form a large percentage of my email box. There are complaints that some potholes are filled but large adjacent potholes are left unfilled because "they are not on the system"! I would like to reiterate that the best way to point out a pothole is online, using the DCC website. I have no more power over the system than you.

Lastly you may be aware that at the next elections in May you will need photo ID to be able to vote. This means a valid passport, driving licence with photo or bus pass. I recommend that you register for a postal vote. It costs nothing and you have a 2 week window in which to vote. You can contact Electoral Services in MDDC or if in doubt contact me.

County Councillor Newsletter—March

As we move towards the May elections I would like to bring 2 things to people's notice. In order to vote you will need photo identity. Obviously you can use your passport, modern driving licence or your over 65's bus. If you have none of these it is possible to get a photo identity form by going online to www.gov.uk and follow the instructions for downloading a photo ID form. Unfortunately you do need to do this online and you will need a photograph that you have on your device. The other alternative is to apply to Mid Devon District Council's electoral services (01884 234318) for a postal vote. This has two advantages the first is that you do not need a photo ID and the second is that when you have the forms through you will have a two-week window in which to vote and so you do not need to go out on that rainy Thursday when you would much rather stay at home. In order to facilitate this I shall be bringing some postal vote forms with me to my surgeries.

I would like to remind you all that as the weather is improving I shall start my surgeries in March. I shall keep to the roads I used last year namely the 1st Saturday of the month Crediton, the 2nd Saturday Cheriton Bishop at 10 and Yeoford at 11, the 3rd Saturday at Coplestone and the 4th Saturday in the village hall in Bow. If you cannot get my surgeries do remember you can contact me by e-mail on frank.letch@devon.gov.uk.

Cont:

I have attended one interesting and important meeting which was highways. There is a programme of road repairs which is undertaken in summer by 16 gangs but in winter this number is augmented by contractors to 40. There is a new idea that when inspectors go out to look at potholes that are on the system they will also mark up any nearby that they think need repair! During the meeting I did raise the question of road signs indicating road ahead closed. Obviously if it is an emergency we have no warning which can lead to inconvenience but repairs have to be done there and then. I did raise a question about going along the A377 and finding signs on the road that give you the impression that you are on the road that will be closed ahead but often it is a road off to the side. We are pushed for signs with a 90 degree line to indicate a side road closure.

I am sure many of you breathed a sigh of relief at the halting of the high increase in car park charges, Our petitions and cogent arguments help sway the change of heart!

CREDITON HAMLETS PARISH COUNCIL


At the February Parish Council meeting Cllr Frank Letch (DCC) reported that Devon County Council is running a consultation on whether to charge for parking on Crediton High Street. (This is also being proposed in seven other towns in Devon).

Cllr Beasley reported that she had received a request for an additional grit bin to be located near the telephone box on Station Road. The Clerk was asked to obtain DCC Highways approval of the location and to put the item on the March agenda.

Cllr Yarnold updated councillors on the proposed bus shelter for Yeoford. Information has been included in the Crediton Courier and the Village Voice and Cllr Yarnold awaits any comments residents may have.

Cllr Price reported that he hopes to be permitted to carry out work to improve drainage on the road near the Punchbowl Recycling Centre in a few weeks.

The next meeting will be on Monday 6th March at Yeoford Community Hall. The meeting will commence at 7.30 pm. If you would like to read the full minutes of the February Parish Council meeting, they are on the PC website. 
