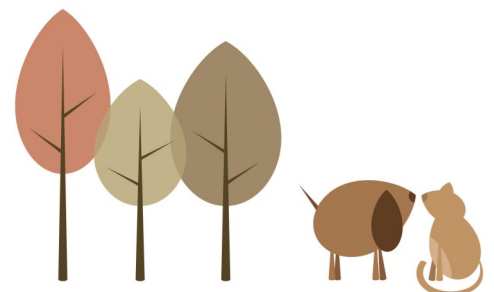

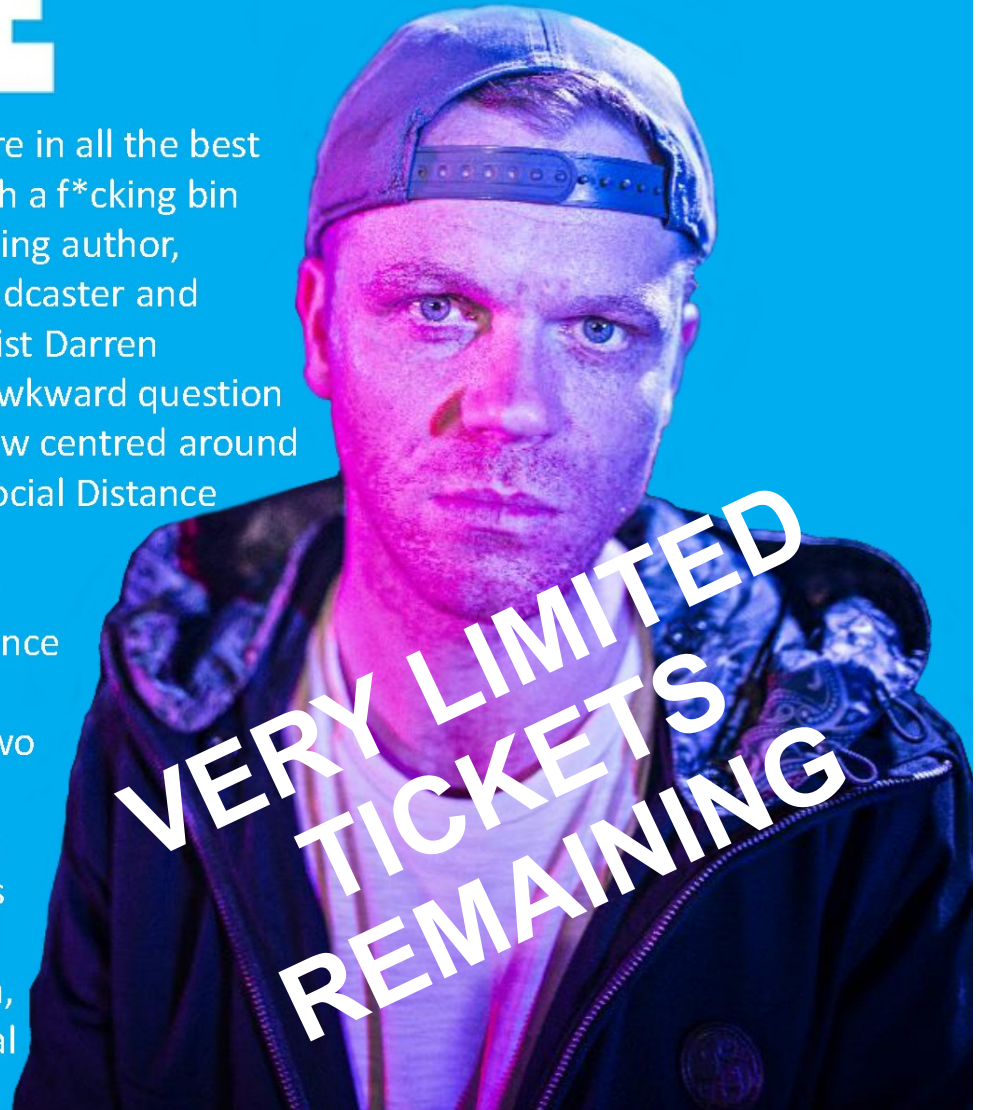

At the April Parish Council meeting Councillors Price and Yarnold gave an update on the proposed bus shelter for Yeoford. A verbal quotation of £2650 has been received for a shelter measuring 3.6m x 2.4m. Councillors resolved to approve the quotation and also to approve expenditure of £800 for the concrete base. Councillors asked the Clerk to obtain a written quotation and renew the application for a grant towards the cost from the Locality Fund.

Councillors discussed plans in the Parish for the celebration of the upcoming coronation and voted to contribute £150 to Yeoford Village Hall Committee to help fund activities in Yeoford.

The Annual Parish Meeting will commence at 7pm on Monday the 15th of May at Yeoford Community Hall. The Annual Parish Meeting is not a formal meeting and does not have an agenda. It is an opportunity for parishioners to raise or debate issues in the Parish and Councillors invite residents to join the meeting and speak up.

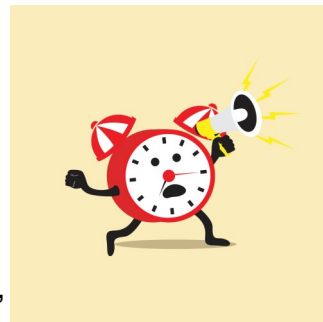
There are many awful events taking place around the world involving loss of life and countries pretending to be under threat to justify aggression.
